To add waves use a hot curling iron. Try the Babyliss Pro Porcelain Conical Wand which is a bit of a splurge at €69.99. It's one of the easiest tongs to use. Hold the wand vertically to create a spiral effect, winding the hair in the direction away from the face. The rule of thumb is the bigger or thicker the sections, the softer and bigger the waves. Keep the root smooth with the movement on the lengths and ends.

The look is perfect for all ladies with fine-to-medium straight hair who want sexy, bouncy, tousled locks. This style works best on hair that's shoulder length or longer.
